DAY 1 (4TH AUGUST, 2023)

The Missions train moved to Bonwire Senior High School with Fourteen (14) Missionaries expecting three to join later. The team set off around 1:50 pm from Kumasi and arrived by the Grace of God at Bonwire at 2:25 pm. Missionaries were engaged in Two-hour prayers as they prepared to go to the school to hold our first meeting. The session was led by the vice-chair Rev. Richmond Osei Duah. Our Chairperson Evangelist Kim who encouraged team members to be focused on the assignment at hand and to endeavour to give their best for the course and also called for their consistency in all other activities of the ministry. By 5 p.m. the team went to the school campus to set up for our first night.



The Evening of the first night started at 7:30 pm with prayers, praise and Adoration word of Ministration was given by our Chairperson Lady Evangelist who charged the house with a word of exhortation from Luke 7:38- 50 which was about the woman who poured a jar of Alabaster oil on the feet of Jesus Christ.



The student body was encouraged not to be shy or hindered from coming to Jesus, for the woman was not ashamed to go to the house of the Pharisee to meet Jesus Christ. The end of the message was followed by an altar call where 42 students convicted by the Holy Spirit made the decision to run in the loving arms of the Lord Jesus Christ and accepted Him as their Lord and Saviour, surrendering their lives to Him.



The students came in their numbers, the auditorium was filled. The Programme ended at exactly 9:10 pm and the Missionaries moved to their residence and made prayers thanking God and asking for greater Grace and strength for the next day's activities. Missionaries retired to bed sleep at midnight.

DAY 2 (5TH AUGUST, 2023)

The rising time of missionaries was 5 a.m. for their usual morning devotion. We had our team member Bro Hunnor leading us in prayer for twenty minutes, Bro George (Logistics Manager) giving us word exhortation and Bro Blessing led the last session of prayer for the morning. Missionaries prepared and moved from their lodging place to the campus by 9 a.m. The morning session started from 10 am to 12:30 pm and was designated for mass discipleship class and one-on-one counselling.




A total of 545 people were discipled using the Ministry's discipleship booklet - titled "AM BORN, AGAIN WHAT NEXT"?

By 12:30 pm both students and missionaries retired to have lunch and rest for the subsequent activities of the day.

The day's activities continued with three different talks. First Academic progression, career life and cut-off points for various universities. Students were encouraged to make maximum use of their time in school since they are in a competitive generation. They were also encouraged on the need to learn a skill or trade alongside their academic pursuit. The session was led by Bro Ben Praise a final I.CT student at AMMUSTED.



Talk two was led by Sis Alberta Naana Frimpong a law student and an entrepreneur who took the student body through Cyber Security narrowing down on the wrong use of social media and its future repercussions.

The last talk was led by Sis Drusilla Owusuaa a final year Degree Nursing Student. She was focused on Purity Campaign. She elaborated on God's intention about sex and that sex is not just to satisfy our desires. Also, she made the student's body aware of the physical, psychological and spiritual implications of sex outside the original intent God created it to be. It was a powerful moment during these talks. The afternoon session ended successfully as there was a break for Missionaries and the student body to prepare for the evening sessions. Student participation and comportment were very encouraging during each session.



The evening session began around 6:45 pm with our opening prayers, praises and Adoration.



The night was designated for Gospel Musical explosion.

The auditorium was fully packed as students were glued to their seats. Students ministered to us with songs and drama. The night was blissful when our guest Gospel Minister Ben Osei graced the night with powerful praise and worship.



The atmosphere was charged with the power of the Holy Spirit as people surrendered to the Lord through the music. Scripture was indeed fulfilled when the night was also characterized with Prayers from our convener the Lady Evangelist Kim. We saw the mighty arm of the Lord as people surrendered wholeheartedly unto God, renounced evil actions, brought out their charms, and broke out of addiction and the influence of evil spirits. To the glory of the Lord, one hundred and twenty-three souls (123) were saved during this night. What a night we had!

DAY 3 (6TH AUGUST 2023)

It was another beautiful Sunday morning. The curtain was finally to be drawn. The Missionaries together with the student body had a wonderful Sunday church service. We began with our prayers, praises and worship as usual. By the grace of God, during the Testimonies time, we had a couple of students dropping their Testimonies to the praise of God.



The Word and Altar Call was led by our very own Lady Pastor Racheal Agyei Kyem who exhorted the house with the story of the prodigal son(Luke 15:11) and exhorted the house of the loving arms of God which is forever opened to anyone and that no one is beyond repair. She urged the house to forget about their past and run to Christ just as they are. To the praise of God, an altar call was made and 20 souls gave their lives to Christ.






IMPACT STORIES
